Dear RHS Seniors and Juniors,

August 2026

We are excited to begin a new year here at RHS and know that many of you are eager for information regarding parking as you prepare to come back to school. Please review the parking procedures in the Student-Parent Handbook carefully as you are responsible for all the conditions under which the permit is granted.

Seniors and Juniors who wish to obtain a parking space may do so by signing the Student-Parent Handbook, clearing all obligations, and completing an online application that requires a digital upload of both your driver's license and the registration of the car for which the parking sticker is being issued. Student parking eligibility will be reviewed when students apply for a parking permit, and students' parking violation history will be taken into consideration (per the Student-Parent Handbook).

The link for the parking application can be found [here](#). You must use your ridgefieldps.net account to access the application. Although both Seniors and Juniors can submit applications beginning on Friday, August 14, **Senior applications will be processed first, between the dates of August 14 and August 21.** Processing for Junior applications will begin **Monday, August 24.** Junior applications will be time stamped as they come in and will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Please note that submitting an application does not guarantee a parking permit. In light of the fact that parking is primarily a Senior Class privilege, Seniors who do not receive their license prior to August 21 may still submit an application starting August 14 to reserve a spot for when they do obtain their license during the school year; please see specific directions on the application.

Please be sure to clear all obligations and sign the Student-Parent Handbook. If you are eligible to obtain a parking permit after review, you will receive a confirmation email and a \$200 fee will appear on your PowerSchool account. All parking fees are paid by credit card via MySchoolBucks, which can be accessed through the parent portal in PowerSchool. Once payment is received, students will be able to pick up their parking sticker beginning on **Monday, August 24**, at the attendance window between the hours of 8am - 2pm.

If a student who has purchased a parking pass needs to drive a family car to school that does not have a sticker due to a brief extenuating circumstance, they can obtain a free day pass from Ms. Mitten in the attendance office. Seniors or Juniors who have not purchased a parking sticker and have an extenuating circumstance may request permission in the attendance office for day parking along the softball field fence. A fee of \$5 per day will be charged.

All vehicles parked on campus must display a valid parking sticker that is permanently affixed to the lower right side of the front windshield on the passenger's side. Parking stickers are not deemed valid if they are taped to the windshield. Lost parking stickers can be replaced for a \$25 fee. Seniors and Juniors have the option of parking in either the Community Entrance Lot (Lot A) or the Promenade Entrance Lot (Lot B), excluding specific teacher parking spaces in Lot B.
